Examination System:

Annual examination will be conducted by the West Bengal Nursing Council in the month of August/September. Supplementary examination will be conducted every six months.

Eligibility for Examination:

A candidate must have 80% attendance in theory and 100% attendance in practical in each subject for appearing for examination. However the absenteeism has to be made up during the summer vacation.

Award of Diploma and Registration:

Successful candidates will be awarded Diploma in G.N.M. by West Bengal Nursing Council They will be eligible for registration with the Nursing Council of any State in India.
